



## 2019 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarterly Report

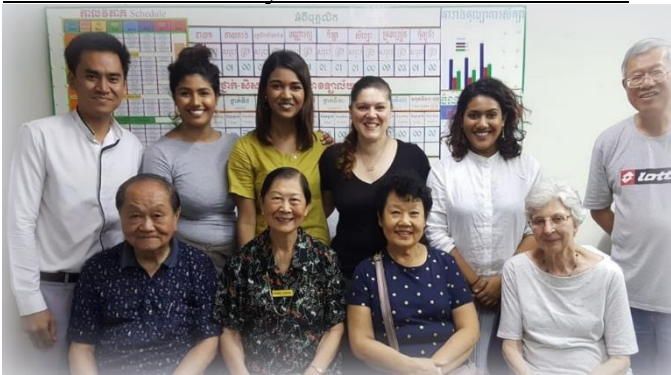
